The Pallot family pies originated in1927 in a small bakery in Kondinin. The family was always on the go, owning a bakery in every small town they lived in. Moving to Bridgetown in 1935, Northam in 1937 for only a year, the family then moved to Cunderdin until 1972. Whilst in Cunderdin the family also owned a bakery in Meckering from 1966, until it was brought down by the earthquake in 1968. In 1972 the family moved to the big city hoping for bigger and better things.

That's exactly what they got. In 1972 the famous Bake-Inn Pie Shop was established selling famous pies pasties and sausage rolls for 23 years, until 1998. At the same time from 1992-1997 the family owned Tasty Bake in Garden City Shopping Centre. From then the family moved once again to Trackside Bakery, making and baking award winning pies, sausage rolls and pasties. Still using the same traditional recipes for pies and bread, four generations later, they must be good!
